Mr. W. L. Kinsell:

On April 3rd Russell Plow Extra 701 South stuck in the snow at Mile Post 308. It was necessary to send Rotary outfit from Anchorage to get them out. For your information, Dispatcher called Roundhouse at 9:35 P.M. and was unable to raise anyone until about 10:20 P.M. and your Night Foreman was told what was wanted and at 11:00 P.M. he called back and said that it would be 1:00 A.M., or later, before this outfit would be ready. However, he was unable to give us a figure as to when to call the crew. It was then decided to wait until the regular south end snow crew was available which was 2:00 A.M. The forty to forty-five minutes time which was consumed in raising the Roundhouse was rather excessive.
